We're building a better Pawtucket and we need your help

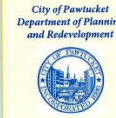

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is continuing design analysis to address the replacement of the existing bridge carrying NY Route 79 over the Chenango River in the Towns of Barker and Fenton in Broome County.

As part of the preliminary design phase, NYSDOT is conducting a **Visual Impact Assessment** and has developed this Visual Preference Survey to better understand the visual preferences amongst people who live, work, travel or recreate within the NY Route 79 project corridor. The survey is separated into three parts and will take approximately 20 minutes to complete. Your feedback is valuable and will be considered in the overall development of the NY Route 79 over Chenango River Bridge Project.
